

RoHS Statement at Troax AB

RoHS "Restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances"

EU Directive 2002/95/EC (RoHS) and 2015/863/EU (RoHS 3)

Dear Customer,

In this letter Troax AB wants to inform you that we are aware of what the RoHS Directive means to us.

The products that Troax AB manufacture are mesh panels and accessories consisting of steel, iron and powder coating and comply with the RoHS Directive.

We hereby confirm that articles supplied by Troax AB are not in conflict with the above mentioned European Directives.

The following substances or compounds containing these substances are not contained nor intentionally added, this means that the articles are not containing any of the below mentioned chemicals to such an extent that they are unusable for RoHS critical end products.

- Cadmium (Cd): < 100 ppm
- Lead (Pb): < 1000 ppm
- Mercury (Hg): < 1000 ppm
- Hexavalent Chromium: (Cr VI) < 1000 ppm
- Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB): < 1000 ppm
- Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE): < 1000 ppm
- Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP): < 1000 ppm
- Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP): < 1000 ppm
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP): < 1000 ppm
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP): < 1000 ppm

Other materials consisting of plastic such as top cover, end plug, plastic handle and Polycarbonate (PC) comply with the RoHS Directive.

Electrical switches used for Safe-Lock follow the regulations of RoHS directive.
